This exhibition in the Art Gallery of the renowned community arts centre, The Tabernacle, consists of the works of local painters representing the Portobello Artists Group.

The group was founded in 1989 by painter and printmaker Ron Best. It is a group run by artists of diverse artistic and cultural backgrounds living in the Portobello area wishing to exhibit innovative, exciting works. The objective of the group is to promote the visual arts within the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea and beyond, by mounting regular exhibitions as well as providing workshop facilities to support the arts in education and to create opportunities for individual artists. Since the Group's foundation in 1989 Ron Best has organized a very large number of art exhibitions and workshops, with support from the Westway Development Trust. For many years, he has been the the organiser of the Notting Hill Arts Festival; a successful show took place last August in the huge empty space of the old Post Office Sorting office in Westbourne Grove.

This current exhibition at The Tabernacle organised by Ron, provides an opportunity to view the quality and artistic originality that flourishes in the hidden studios of artists living in and around Portobello, representing some of the best art produced in London today. The exhibition has the support of a large number of shops and other businesses in the area.
